SCHROON LAKE, NY. Broadway veterans and husband and wife, Steve Elmore and Carolyn Marcell will be guest starring in Seagle Music Colony's upcoming production of Stephen Sondheim's musical *Company*. Steve brings a unique perspective to the production since he was in the original Broadway cast of the show. "Our young artists, collaborating with Steve and director Richard Kagey, will have the opportunity to ask questions about their characters and get answers from someone that worked directly with the composer during the creation and first performances of the show both on Broadway and in London," says Artistic Director Darren K. Company was originally premiered on Broadway in the 1970's and has had two very successful Broadway revivals since then.
