### SEAGLE MUSIC COLONY TO HOST TWO INSTRUMENTAL CONCERTS

SCHROON LAKE, NY. Seagle Music Colony will play host to two post-season instrumental music concerts in the coming weeks. "We're happy to be able to host these two concerts and enrich the cultural offerings here in Schroon Lake for another week into the summer past our regular season of musicals and operas," says Seagle Music Colony General Director, Tony Kostecki.

First will be a duo piano concert to be held at the Oscar Seagle Memorial Theatre on Wednesday, August 17, 2011 at 8:00 pm. Tickets for this one-night-only performance will be sold at the door. The ticket price is \$15 and all proceeds will benefit the non-profit Seagle Music Colony.

On Sunday, August 21 at 2:00 pm, the Oscar Seagle Memorial Theatre will again host a chamber music concert presented by the Lake George Chamber Orchestra. The concert will be the culminating event of a three-day amateur chamber music camp being held on the Seagle Music Colony campus. The concert features the professional faculty of the chamber music camp – violinist Amanda

Brin, cellist, Jonathan Brin and pianist Steven Beck. The program for the concert includes music of Beethoven, Chopin and Smetana. Tickets for the concert will be \$15 and will be available at the door.
